

Flying Heels Rodeo Rules

We are a WRA co-approved rodeo and CJRA rules apply to the Junior rodeo, thus rules in the 2011 rulebook apply with these exceptions/additions:

- ☒ Contestants **MUST** enter and exit through the same gate for timed events.
- ☒ **HAT RULE**-A five-second time penalty will be assessed for any lost hats in the Junior Rodeo Barrel Racing & Pole Bending and the Open Rodeo Barrel Racing.
- ☒ **Absolutely no running the gate in the timed events during the Jr. Rodeo!**
- ☒ Team Roping cattle are chute run.
- ☒ Only two loops are allowed in the Junior Rodeo Junior-Senior Team Roping.
- ☒ Only one loop is allowed in the Junior Rodeo Breakaway Roping.
- ☒ Open Barrel Racing- no circling for barrels prior to crossing timer, please see WRA rulebook.
- ☒ Western dress required as in the WRA & CJRA rule book and defined as long-sleeve button down collar and cuff shirt (no exceptions), pants, boots and cowboy hat.
- ☒ Rodeo committee *may* give contestant option to run 2 head if less than 4 entries. Would pay average & fast time, all money counts for awards.
- ☒ Flying Heels Series does NOT pay ground money- it rolls to next week.
- ☒ Flying Heels Series does NOT pay day money, as it is considered one performance, even if there is slack.
- ☒ Turn-outs will be assessed a fee.
- ☒ Juniors must ride horse through pattern on their own (no leading allowed).
- ☒ Ropers, **please** stay out of the arena unless you are up, on deck, in the hole.
- ☒ Contestants may enter online or phone from 5-9pm on Monday prior to rodeo www.granbyrodeo.com
- ☒ Any FHAA member has the authority to remove any non-contestants from behind the bucking chutes for safety purposes.
- ☒ **Please remember that spectators help pay for the rodeo, so... compete with good sportsmanship, show them why rodeo is the #1 sport and participate in the FHAA Grand Entry.**
